I, the undersigned, declare that after reasonable review, the goods that Watlow Electric Manufacturing Company or its subsidiary supplies to your organization, does not knowingly:

- incorporate semifinished or finished steel/metal products originating in Russia or Belarus.
- procure semifinished or finished steel/metal products directly or indirectly from Russia or Belarus, that are restricted for import into the EU, UK, or any other country, including, but not limited to, pursuant to the below regulations.
- contain products that are processed in a third country and contain iron and/or steel products, directly or indirectly, also as referenced in the foregoing:
  - Annex XVII, as per article 3 g of (EU) Council Regulation No 833/2014 concerning ‘restrictive measures in view of Russia’s actions destabilising the situation in Ukraine’; and
  - Schedule 3B, as per Regulation 46IA and 46IB of the (UK) Russia Sanctions Regulations.

I understand that this Declaration may be disclosed to customs authorities or other governmental entities, and I undertake to make available to the customs authorities or other governmental entities any further supporting documents they require related to the topic of this Declaration.
